How does the navigation work?

Your driver's TomTom GO uses the Global Positioning System (GPS), which sends signals via satellites to GPS receivers. From these signals your TomTom GO can calculate its current position, destination and speed. GPS signals are free and work 24 hours a day, in any weather conditions, anywhere in the world.

How do all the different parts connect with each other?

Actually it's quite straightforward. Each vehicle navigates by its TomTom GO and uses its TomTom LINK to communicate with TomTom WEBFLEET via the mobile network. While the information between TomTom WEBFLEET and your PC travels via the internet, using a secure data connection. All of which gives you smart, easy, connected navigation. In real-time and managed from any point where you've got access to the internet.

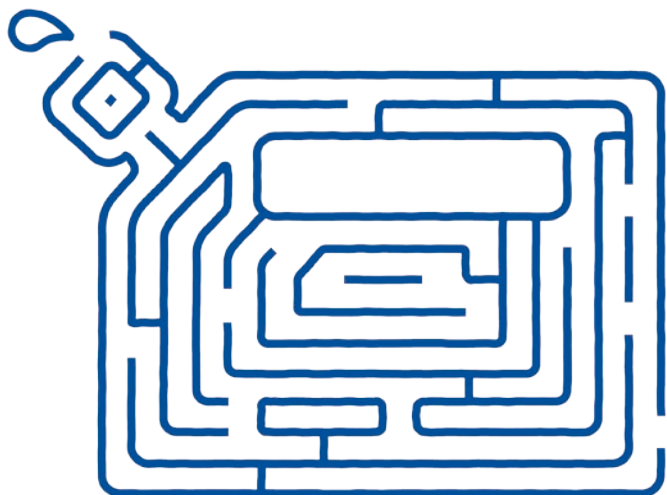
